

Screening Tool for Toronto Region Service Providers

Coordinated Service Planning

The objective of Coordinated Service Planning (CSP) is to provide children and youth with multiple and/or complex special needs and their families living in the city of Toronto with a seamless and family-centred service coordination experience. In order to complete a referral to CSP, a child and family must meet two of the criteria from the child/youth category and family category listed below. Please obtain consent before submitting a referral.

Mandatory Eligibility Requirement:

- Child/Youth is under the age of 18, or is between the ages of 18 and 21 and is still in school
- Child/Youth and family reside in the City of Toronto

Referral Criteria:

Characteristics of the Child/Youth (must meet two criteria):

- Challenges related to multiple areas of their development (including physical, communication, intellectual, emotional, social and/or behavioural development)
- Require services from multiple sectors and/or professionals
- Are likely to have ongoing service needs
- Are likely to have needs requiring the use of technology

Characteristics of the family (must meet two criteria):

- Coping strengths and adaptability
- Health and well-being of other family members
- Literacy and/or language barriers
- Other family/life events which may contribute to the family's level of distress
- Limited social/community supports
- Competing demands of caregiving and employment
- Financial instability
